

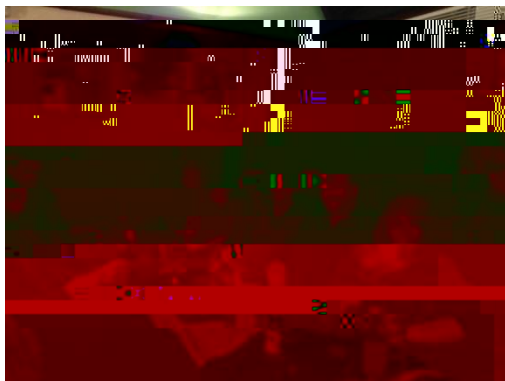
# *The Walters Front*

## School liaison

The school liaison committee meets each term, with each House invited to send along two  
representatives providing parents the opportunity of voicing opinions and concerns. There

The Assistant Pastoral Head (APH) has indicated that the school will review the dispensation  
of chapel suits.

Following several requests via the liaison committee, a rain shelter for the car park area is  
being planned.

Several houses had raised concerns about the quality and quantity of food served by school.  
This is being investigated.

There was a discussion about use of the gym for pupils under 16 and the Deputy Head Master  
(DHM) advised that this would not change because of health and safety legislation.

Concerns were raised about the lack of car parking facilities at pick up time. These are ongoing  
and will be investigated. There is additional pressure on parking as sixth formers are unable to  
use facilities at Houseman Hall, but this situation will be resolved from September 2014.
